

# Confined Space Awareness



## Course Outline

Safety Results "Confined Space Awareness" courses are designed to assist employers and employees in understanding the characteristics, hazards and legislative requirements needed to safely manage work within confined spaces.

Participants are guided through recognition of typical hazardous conditions relating to confined spaces; including oxygen depletion, combustible atmospheres and atmospheric contaminants.

The process of hazard identification, duties of confined space operators, standby personnel and rescue procedures are presented in a classroom environment; with opportunities to discuss how these would be implemented at individual sites.

Participants are encouraged throughout the program to participate and contribute to classroom discussions and activities covering the safe management of confined spaces; from planning and execution through to completion of confined space activities.

This course is designed for participants with no prior confined space experience, and who will be managing work within confined spaces and issuing work permits. This course does not include a practical component. Participants who will be working in a confined space or acting in a standby capacity should consider the "Confined Space Entry" or "Confined Space Rescue" programs.
